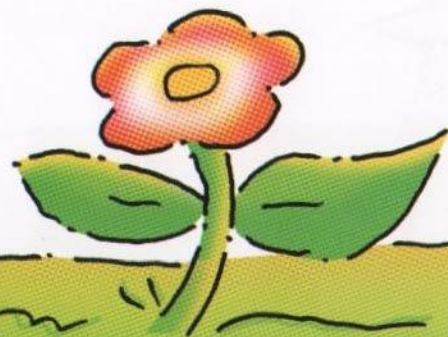

Many years ago there was only Allah ﷻ and nothing else.

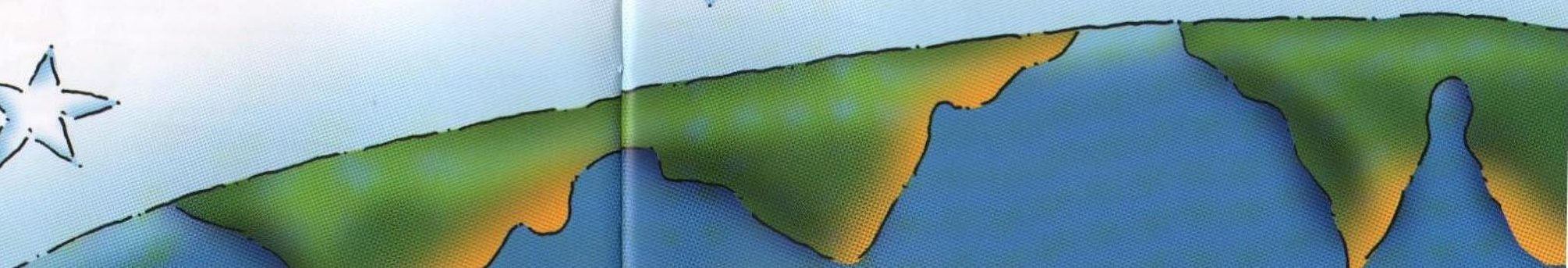
Allah ﷻ is the Lord, the King and the Owner of everything that we see around us. We all have to obey Him for He is the Greatest.



He, Allah ﷻ is the only Creator of the rising sun, glowing moon, twinkling stars, rounded earth and the mighty heavens.

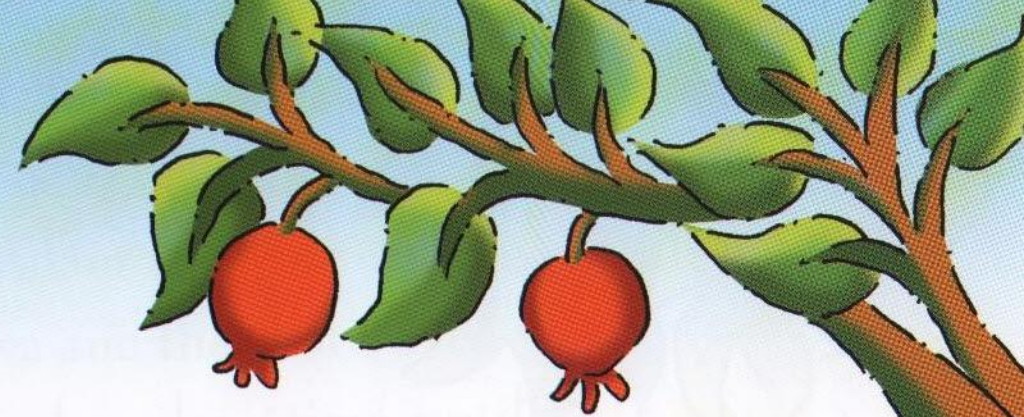


Allah ﷻ then covered the earth with
