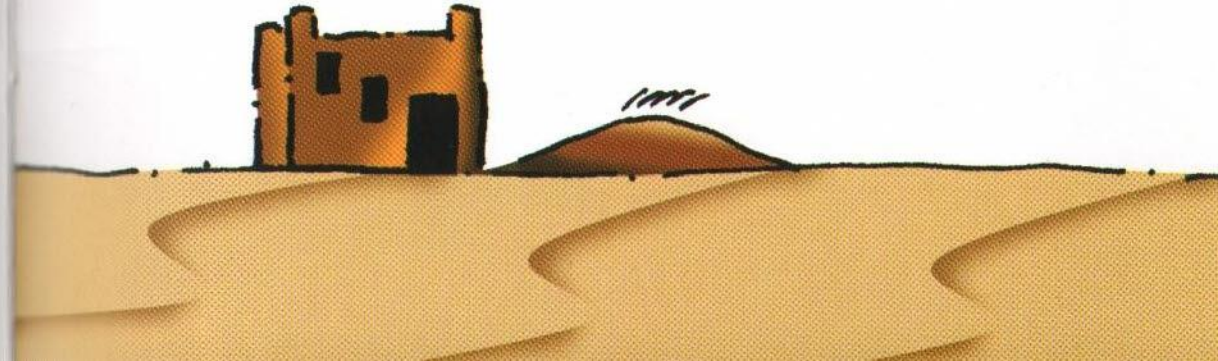



statue maker.

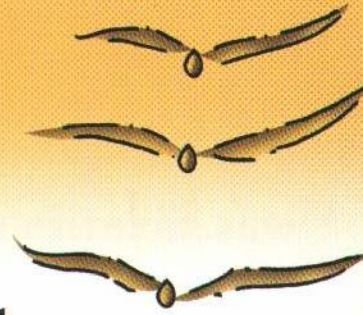
One day Ibrahim عليه السلام asked"
