

Creation of the Universe

The true description from Islam

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Notice: This book has been written in light of the primary sources of evidence in Islam, namely the Quran and the Sunna (traditions of Prophet Muhammad). All evidences used in the book have been referenced.

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Our God and your God is One (Quran 29:46)¹⁹

Many people believe in God but refuse to believe in Allah, thinking Allah is someone other than God. Yet Allah is God. For all those who believe in The One God, The Creator of the universe, then know that our God and your God is one. Allah is He Who created the universe, sustains the universe and regulates the affairs of the universe. He is The Lord of the universe and all that it contains. And for all those who believe in The God of Noah, Abraham, Moses and Jesus, then know that our God and your God is one. Allah is The God of mankind, The Lord of mankind who created us and those before us. He created Adam and Eve and from them He created the entire human race. He chose prophets from amongst them who called the people back to His sole worship, from Noah to Muhammad, peace and blessings be upon them all. Then let it be known that Allah is not only recognized by Muslims. Allah is God, The All Mighty, The Most High.

Allah! There is no god but Him (Quran 20:8)²⁰

And for all those who believe in God then know that our God and your God is the only God and there is no god but Him. There are no gods besides Him nor does He have sons or daughters. He alone is God and He has no partners of any kind. With Him is complete Oneness and To Him belongs all worship with none besides Him having such right. None has the right to be worshipped but Him for He is The Creator and everything else besides Him is merely His creation.

To Him belong The Most Perfect Names (Quran 20:8)²¹

Allah has kept Himself unseen, He has not kept Himself unknown, creating mankind with the inherent ability to know Him, and sending prophets with scriptures to remind mankind about the truth concerning their Lord. In the Quran Allah informs us of His Names and Attributes which describe His Life, His Self and His Actions. These Most Beautiful Names describe His Perfect attributes and through knowing them we increase in our knowledge of Him. Truly knowledge of The Creator

is the noblest of all knowledge for all other knowledge pertains to creation.

Verily your God is indeed One (Quran 37:4)²²

And from His Names we know He is Al Waahid,²³ meaning The One. He is numerically one. He is not two nor is He part of some trinity. There are no gods besides Him. He is The One God who is One and Prevailing.²⁴

Say, He is Allah The One (Quran 112:1)²⁵

Allah has described His Oneness with further depth of meaning when He describes Himself as being Al Ahad,²⁶ meaning The One and Distinct with uniqueness in all aspects of His existence. This carries a deeper meaning, more florid, expressive and assertive than Him being one numerically as from this Name we know He is completely unique with all His attributes belonging only to Him.

Allah The Eternal (Quran 112:2)²⁷

He describes Himself as Al Samad,²⁸ The One who has Eternal Existence. He is Eternal by virtue of who He is. He is everlasting and perpetually abiding.²⁹ He has no beginning and has always existed. He has no end and will always exist. Beginning and end, these are mere attributes He has given His creation.

He begets not nor was He begotten (Quran 112:3)³⁰

Allah has no son nor does He have a daughter. He does not beget nor was He begotten. His Life is not derived from another nor is it imparted to another for there is no god but Him. He has no parents or forefathers having no genealogy or ancestral trace. He has no wife nor does He have sons or daughters. He is The One God who is Alone and His Life remains with Him.
