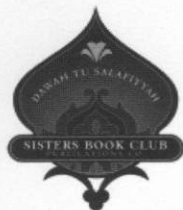


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**Oh My Noble Sisters! Work For Your Hereafter**

## BRIEF BIOGRAPHY

She is Umm Ahmed Salwaa Hasan Subki (*may Allâh preserve her*), with a *Tazkiyah* (recommendation diploma), in *Aqeedah* (Islâmic Creed), she teaches the sisters in Medina from her home. She also connects to the *Shuyookh* (scholars), via telephone [meaning she will call the *Shuyookh* (scholars), directly for clarity, while the sisters are at her home attending her class to show the importance of connecting to them.

Her teachers were and are as follows:

- Shaikh Bin Baaz (*may Allâh have mercy on him*), he advised her to study *Kitaab At-Tawheed* and in doing so; she had to call the Shaikh, so that he can hear what she understood from the lessons.
- Shaikh Uthaymeen (*may Allâh have mercy on him*), she studied *Aqeedah Al-Wasitiyah*, again she would have to call the Shaikh to inform him of what she understood from the lessons.

- She also studies with Shaikh Ubayd Al-Jaabiree (*may Allâh preserve him*).
- Shaikh Rabee'â Al-Madkhalee (*may Allâh preserve him*). They have a very good relationship and the Shaikh said: "Umm Ahmad is a sister that the sisters can benefit from."
- Shaikh Saalih Ibn Sa'd As-Suhaymi (*may Allâh preserve him*).
- Shaikh Abdullah Ateeq (*may Allâh preserve him*).

Masha 'Allâh! These are just a few names, at any rate she has learned from the *Shuyookh* (scholars), from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia both in Medina and Riyadh, but she said: "I'm still learning, even though I teach, but the most important thing is that the sisters must know that it is a must that we stay in constant connection with the *Shuyookh* (scholars)."
